

Privacy policy - Video surveillance

Information notices pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of European Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR)

Data Controller

Pursuant to the European Regulation 2016/679 (below GDPR), Cassa Depositi e Prestiti S.p.A. (below, CDP), with head office in Rome, Piazza Giuseppe Verdi, 10 (00198) processes your personal data in its capacity as "Data Controller" in compliance with the provisions of law and informing you of the use of the above-mentioned personal data.

Purpose of processing

Your data will be processed exclusively for the pursuit of CDP's institutional purposes and, in particular, to ensure the security of staff and visitors to the company's premises; as well as to protect CDP's assets by preventing and prosecuting any unlawful acts.

Video surveillance activity is based on the pursuit of the legitimate interest (Art. 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) to carry out the processing for the above purposes.

Data recipients

The following will be able to access your data: (i) the Data Controller; ii) employees and collaborators/suppliers of CDP who, acting under the authority of the Data Controller, carry out processing activities, each in relation to their duties.

The list of designated Data Processors is constantly updated and kept on CDP's premises.

Finally, the data may be communicated to public bodies entitled to request it, such as judicial and/or public security authorities.

Data processing method

The video surveillance system allows for real-time viewing and recording of images and is in operation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Viewing and managing the images taken by the video surveillance system are activities reserved for the Data Controller and/or people formally appointed by them. Data is stored using appropriate security measures to prevent access by unauthorized personnel and ensure its confidentiality and integrity. The images in video recordings are retained in accordance with the purposes indicated above and in line with the relevant regulatory provisions on retention periods.

Rights of Data Subjects

You are informed that Art. 15-22 GDPR entitles Data Subjects to exercise specific rights; Data Subjects can obtain from CDP: access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing.

Data Subjects also have the right to object to the processing. In the event of the right of objection being exercised, CDP reserves the possibility of not following up the request, and therefore continuing the processing, if there are binding legal grounds for proceeding with the processing overriding the interests, rights and freedoms of the Data Subject.

The above rights can be exercised by sending a request by post to Cassa Depositi e Prestiti S.p.A., Piazza Giuseppe Verdi n. 10 00198 - Rome, att. Personal Data Protection Officer, or by email directly to said Officer, via the contacts provided in point 1.

Data Subjects also have the right to raise complaints with the Italian Data Protection Authority.
